

Going to inspect houses to enroll new students 2025

As soon as the results of the Grade 5 Government Scholarship Examination were released, the office of the Karlsruhe Children's Center was filled with children and parents from various areas. Then, as usual in other years, they were asked to fill out an application form and bring it back.

We received 40 applications this year. We have to select the poorest children from among them through various methods, because we can only enroll 25 children. Therefore, as per the instructions of the Venerable Vipassi Thero, I and Miss Kanthi used a Tuk Tuk vehicle to inspect the houses of the children who had submitted applications in Gandara, Devinuwara, Kekanadura, Makawita, Nadugala, Bandattara, Thihagoda, Kamburupitiya etc. for two days. Below are the homes of several poor children we met during that trip.





Visiting the houses is a very difficult task. Some children go on very difficult roads without a road. We also had to walk a long distance on roads that were not passable by a Tuk Tuk. Somehow, we successfully completed this visit to the houses and selected 25 students.
